- HEPA Clean Air Filters in every single room
- Additional intraoral suctions to reduce aerosol
- Hydrogen peroxide vapor decontamination
- Autoclave sterilizers to kill all bacteria, viruses and spores
- Social distancing throughout the office and individual patient rooms
